TO ALL TRIAL COUNSEL AND PRO SE PARTIES:

The cases on the attached trial calendar are subject to being called for a trial at any time during the following dates in the month of February, 2013:

February 27, 2013
February 28, 2013

The existence of pending motions does not prevent a case from being listed in the trial calendar or from being called for trial.

Prior to meeting in conference with the presiding judge, or prior to the beginning of the trial session if no conference is held, counsel must fully comply with Probate Rule 16 and any still effective Pretrial Orders.

Counsel must comply with all deadlines in Probate Rule 16 and any previously issued and still effective Pretrial Orders.

Counsel who appear at the court conference must be prepared to argue all pending motions and have full authority to make all decisions relative to trial, including settlement.

Counsel must notify the Register immediately whenever any case on the trial calendar is settled.

1. Motions to continue must be filed no later than **February 1, 2013**. All motions to continue must fully comply with Probate Rules 40 (b) and (c). Specially assigned cases continued by agreement will be reassigned to the bottom of the specially assigned calendar. If a specially assigned case is continued over objection, the presiding judge will determine its future priority. Cases continued from the regular trial calendar will probably retain their position unless the presiding judge determines that the number of prior continuances or the circumstances or the circumstances of the present continuance do not warrant a priority position.

2. Requests for protection must be filed no later than **January 24, 2013**. They may be made by letter to the Register, but are applicable only to critical scheduling conflicts. The court will attempt to accommodate reasonable requests to the extent possible. Requests for protection, which prevent a case from being reached during the trial session, will be treated as a Motion to Continue and must comply with Rule 40.

3. All Motions *in limine* which affect procedures or admissibility of evidence at trial must be filed by not later than **February 1, 2013**.

4. All other motions shall have been previously filed or shall be filed only pursuant to applicable deadlines and the appropriate files.
5. All counsel must file a complete list of all trial witnesses by not later than **January 24, 2013**. The witness list shall include the name, address, and title, if appropriate, of each listed witness.
6. All counsel must file a complete list of all exhibits which they intend to offer at trial by **January 24, 2013**. The exhibit list shall identify each separate item by exhibit number. Counsel shall inspect all exhibits with opposing counsel not later than five days before trial or a trial management/pretrial conference, whichever is earlier. If counsel does not comply with this Order, any exhibit may be excluded upon objection or by the Court *sue sponte*.
7. Trial memoranda which counsel may wish to submit for consideration by the Court must be filed not later than one hour prior to the start of the trial.
8. Other: TRIAL MANAGEMENT CONFERENCES ARE SET FOR _____,
AND ONLY FOR THOSE WHO HAVE DESIGNATED TIMES NOTED ON
THE LIST.
